Tonight is in memory of Cooper Robert Trewin

All proceeds go to the Cooper Trewin Memorial SUDC Research Fund.

Our precious angel Cooper passed away suddenly on Saturday 6th February 2010. He was a healthy and happy 16 month old toddler whose parents could not have been prouder. Cooper passed away from **SUDC (Sudden Unexplained Death in Childhood)** which affects one in 100,000 toddlers above 12 months of age. Currently there is no research being conducted in Australia for SUDC. Research is currently being held in America however it is our goal to have a University in Australia set up research into SUDC with a hope to try and help the families of these small and innocent victims stolen from us well before their time.

As a parent who is told by a pathologist after an autopsy on our son that we had a healthy little boy without sickness, injury or disease and that they cannot give us a reason as to why our son Cooper passed away in his sleep, leaves you with a lot of unanswered questions.

It is now well within our sights to fight for research to be carried out here in Australia! Therefore we have the need to raise sufficient funds to assist with this quest and we have been working closely with Leanne Raven the CEO and Karen Passey the Victorian CEO of SIDS and Kids who are very keen to help us make this dream a reality.

SIDS and Kids have opened a trust account and have agreed to fully support the **Cooper Trewin Memorial SUDC Research Fund** in conjunction with our local Bairnsdale Sunrise Rotary Club.
